

Overview

Our Corporate Bond Strategy invests in a diversified portfolio of largely investment grade bond issues, providing a balance of income and liquidity. The portfolio aims to provide positive total returns, and offers the option of either taking or reinvesting income.

The segregated portfolios are directly invested and designed for private clients, fiduciaries and charities with a minimum of \$1,250,000 available to invest. The Corporate Bond Strategy does not aim to reproduce a "benchmark" return, but rather focuses on meeting investor expectations. The strategy is available in £, \$ and €.


